

**New Durham Board of Selectmen's
Non-Public Minutes**

July 18, 2016

Motion was made by Chairman Bickford to enter Non-public session under RSA 91-A: 3, II (b) Hiring, seconded by Selectman Anthes.

Entered into Non-public session at 7:01 P.M., and adjourned to Selectmen's conference room.

At 7:03 P.M., the Board reconvened in the Selectmen's conference room, where they were joined by Police Officer (Part time) candidate Andrew Croteau of New Durham, NH.

I. Executive Interview- Police Officer.

- a. TA Kinmond introduced Andrew Croteau a candidate for part time Police Officer. TA Kinmond had previously provided the Board with Mr. Croteau's resume and application for employment, which accompanied by a Memo from Chief Bernier recommending Mr. Croteau for appointment as a Part Time Police Officer. Mr. Croteau is currently a full time Police Officer with the Barrington Police Department which he has served for the past 5 years. Mr. Croteau is a graduate of the 156 NH Police Academy, and hold several police training certifications. The candidate was interviewed by the Board of Selectman, and asked question relevant to his current policing tactics, experience, and training. After the interview they thanked Mr. Croteau for his interest and willingness to assist the Police Department as a part time Officer. TA Kinmond advised the Board that he and Chief Bernier have reviewed Mr. Croteau's personal file and find no information which would prevent him from being hired as a Police Officer. TA Kinmond recommend to the Board that if they are

supportive of the Chief's request to hire Mr. Croteau as a Part Time Police Officer, there motion should include the hire being contingent upon the completion of a bridging background investigation and medical examination.

Selectman Swenson made a motion to leave nonpublic session and return to public session, seconded by Selectman Anthes. The motion passed 3-0.

Business in non-public session was concluded at 7:26 p.m.
