The Meeting convened at 4:30 in the parking lot of the New Durham Town Hall.

The committee looked at a barn in nearby Alton that is slated to be taken down. We have an opportunity to purchase the barn with the stipulation that we take it away. This would be a great opportunity for our Boodey House project barn if all the issues of dismantling that come with this can be solved. The barn appeared is good shape. It is post and beam, either late 17th century or very early 18th century, about 42 feet long and 42 wide. It does have a hole in a corner of the roof and some sill issues. It does not have a basement, but sits on rocks which we can have also. With very few exceptions the beams in the framework appear in good shape.

All agreed that if we can figure out the mechanics of dismantling, moving and the storing of the barn as well as handling the expense of all this, it would be a good deal for our project.

The Chair distributed copies of an updated fund balance Chair report. The fund balance has increased due to an anonymous \$2,000.00 donation, thus the balance without accumulate interest to date is \$13,752.42. The minutes from the May 7th meeting were distributed to the members for their review and to vote on at the next meeting. Next scheduled meeting is June 19th at 7pm at the Town Hall.
