Town of New Durham Capital Improvement Program Advisory Committee Minutes of the November 5, 2015 Meeting

1. Call to Order: By Chair Jarvis at 7:04 PM.

2. Approval of the 10/15/15 Minutes:

- ➤ Edits were made to the RSMS relative to Ten Rod Road and identification of CRFs and ETFs that the CIP Committee has not always reviewed.
- ➤ **MOTION**: *To approve the October 15, 2015 CIP minutes as amended.* (Bonanno/Bickford) Vote: 5-0-0.

3. Highway Department Equipment:

➤ Grader: Terry J. presented a spread sheet analyzing the cost of the Town owning and operating a grader versus contracting for grader services. (See attachment.) Both Tony and Resident Greg Anthes disagreed with the costs for the grader operator. After reviewing the 2014 Town Report employee compensation figures the hourly wage was changed from \$ 30/hour to \$ 32.30/hour. Tony asked for a breakdown of the 556 hours that are cited in the cost analysis. As a result the hourly cost for the grader, when owned and operated by the Town, became \$ 74.48 while the contractor hourly cost remained at \$ 100/hour. Even though the hourly cost for contracted grader services was over \$ 25.00/hour more Tony, David and Denis did not want to change their decision to cease funding for a replacement grader in 2026.

<u>Loader Backhoe</u>: Tony presented information from Milton Cat regarding different size loader backhoes As all the gravel has been mined from the town gravel pit Tony suggested that the Town not replace, the JD 544 loaderthat is owns.. The Town's CAT 520 loader backhoe can perform all of the remaining tasks that the JD 544 currently performs including loading spreaders in the winter. (See attached email.) He suggested that the Town look at a Caterpillar 450F loader backhoe. The Caterpillar loader backhoe has a 2.0 cubic yard bucket versus the Town's 1.5 cubic yard loader backhoe. Tony feels that since the loader is not used that often that it would be cheaper to contract for the equipment, as needed. **MOTION**: *To not fund the replacement of the JD 544 loader*. (Bonanno/Bickford) <u>Discussion</u>: Terry J. stated that she would like to hear from the Road Agent before agreeing to no longer fund for a replacement loader backhoe. Vote: 4 (Bickford, Bonanno, Chabot, Martina)-1-0.

MOTION: *To upgrade the loader from a 420 to a 450 or equivalent*. (Bonanno/Martin) <u>Discussion</u>: Tony stated that by going to the 450 or equivalent the capacity of the loader would be increased over that of the JD 544. This would occur in 2028 when the current loader is scheduled for replacement. The cost of the Caterpillar 450F is \$ 40,000 more than the replacement cost of the JD 544 model. Terry C. asked why we would want to spend an additional \$ 40,000. Denis withdrew his 2nd and Tony withdrew his motion.

- Freightliner 4X4 with Plow, Wing and Water Truck: Tony proposed that a replacement for the Freightliner truck no longer be funded, instead contracting the plow work out. Discussion ensued. Concerns included that there were no bids on the 2015 RFP plowing and the lack of recent experience with contracting plow services. The Committee decided to wait before defunding this replacement.
- ➤ <u>Life Expectancy of Plow Trucks</u>: Terry J. brought up the fact that based on research done by the former Equipment Mechanic the Road Agent is recommending that all of the 6 wheel plow trucks have their life expectancy changed from 10 years to 12 years. **MOTION:** *To change the life expectancy of the 6 wheel plow trucks from 10 to 12 years.* (Jarvis/Bickford) Vote 5-0-0.
- 6. Next Meeting: The next meeting will be November 13, 2015 at 1 PM at the Fire Station Community Room.
- 7. Adjournment: MOTION: To adjourn. (Bickford/Martin) Meeting adjourned at 9:16 PM
