## Conceptual Review - Gravel Pit - Keith Babb (Map 219 Lot 5) - Kings Highway

Chairman Drummey recognized Mr. Varney as representative for Mr. Babb. The gravel pit will be closed and reclaimed in its current state-not all remaining gravel will be used. Mr. Varney described the reclamation process.

Chairman Drummey asked if end product of site will behave like a 'giant dry well' and have excessively fast draining soils. Mr. Babb replied that there is an excess of loam and clay soil on site to overlay the site and that will not be a concern. There were no other questions.

Mr. Varney will come back to the Board with a formal reclamation and subdivision plan.

Mr. Varney then handed out two maps showing a new gravel pit Mr. Babb plans to open on the New Durham/Wolfeboro border on Kings Highway (Map 206 Lot 011).

Vice-Chairman Craycraft asked about estimated truck traffic during maximum excavation. Mr. Babb said almost all traffic will be north into Wolfeboro with maximum load traffic about 70 trucks per day.
