Vice Chairman Doug Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

Discussion took place regarding the application submitted by United Water. Ms. St. Jean said that based on what they were looking for they would have to amend the regulations. The application as presented is multi-use on the property which is not allowed under the zoning regulations. Mr. Nelson said that the application cannot be accepted or addressed because the regulations would have to be amended. Mr. Francis made a motion that the application as submitted is divergent from a single use in a business zone pursuant to Section 4.09C and therefore rejected by the Borough Zoning Commission and accessory use and proposed use are not accessory to main use. Ms. Craddock seconded the motion and was unanimously approved.

Discussion took place regarding the signs on the windows at Wells Fargo. Mrs. St. Jean said they had not been removed and that the next step is a cease and desist.
