Mr. Darrin opened the meeting at 7:02 pm.

Public Participation

Kiera O'Sullivan, a Newtown Girl Scout, would like to earn her "Silver Award". Miss O'Sullivan proposed planting milk weed on an O.S. parcel to attract and feed the endangered Monarch butterflies. The Commission asked Miss O'Sullivan to research the growing conditions of milk weed, look for a viable partial of land, and design a small descriptive sign for the area. The Commission invited Ms. O'Sullivan back after her research was complete.

Ms. Lisa Wahle, Biologist, Marlborough, CT, spoke about the endangered NE Cottontail and a proposed plan to create a protective habitat on the Stonebridge O.S. property. Ms. Whale suggested a forestry management plan which would allow for the regeneration of new growth and a dense thicket for the rabbits. Ms. Whale felt 10 acres would be ideal. The Commission will consider the plan.
