Fire Marshals Report:

Frampton reported for the month of September there were 408 hours, 485 incidents and 126 calls. Total loss for the month was \$2K.

- Hose Testing November 1, 2 and 3rd to begin.
- Total hydrant count 364.
- Boggs Hill Bridge to be opened earlier than planned.

Cragin handed out the DFM applications for review by the Commissioners. Cragin would like to have a Special Meeting to appoint a new DFM. This meeting will take place November 14th at 6:30 p.m. at NH&L.

Standing Committees:

Budget – all budgets have been submitted. The Budget committee will meet and compile all information. The budget is due to the town on November 28th. The next regular monthly meeting for the BOFC is scheduled for November 28th, the budget due date; therefore, a special meeting will need to be scheduled in November.

Truck – McCulloch reported the transfer of the spare truck (#332) to Hawleyville is complete. Still waiting on date from Rick Brown for transmission services. #331 issues resolved. Hawleyville Tanker pumped failed its test. Truck Committee to determine a date to inspect #339.

Radio - no report

Policy and Procedures – no report. Waiting for Dodgingtown commissioner to be announced before appointing new committees.

Hydrant - no report

Purchasing Agent: Bill Halstead will coordinate hose testing. Hurricane bills will be compiled for the next meeting. \$60K YTD in reimbursements for the first quarter of the year for the RIP program.

MOTION: McCulloch made a motion to honor the letter which the five chiefs submitted in May, 2011, to the BOFC which recommended that the purchase of turnout gear, at the individual chief's request, include Globe, Cairns and Morning Pride.

MOTION PASSED AS AMENDED

Nay: Burton

AMENDMENT TO MOTION: Goosman made a motion that the chief's can purchase from the three different manufacturers, at the same purchasing limit, or less.

Seconded: Nezvesky MOTION PASSED Nay: Burton

Wlasuk: feels this undermines the whole purpose of standardizing our equipment.

Goosman: standardization should help lower costs for the BOFC. It has been explained to BF&R the purpose of standardization. The whole town should be taken into consideration.

Burton: the procedure is not correct as we just voted on this motion six months ago. No letter is listed in the minutes. Agrees with Wlasuk and Goosman that standardization should be instituted. If all departments have the same gear each department can share and swap equipment.

Jossick: would like to see the document from Bill Halstead before voting on the motion.

McCulloch - wouldn't questions chief's requests for equipment.

NUSAR: replacing hydrant on Hanover Road boat/state/town launch.
