MARSHAL'S REPORTS:

- The fire company in New York State, which lost one of its members, was fined heavily by OSHA due to lack of training on all types of air packs. All personnel must be trained properly.

Truck: Bolmer reported on sending out bids for servicing the trucks. An \$890 per truck savings would be yielded if service was switched to Tracy's Garage in Derby. After discussion, it was determined that service would begin with them immediately. We will try their service for a year and determine if it is a success. Nezvesky asked Whelan to send to all the Chiefs contact information for Tracy's Garage.

The State work on Route 34 will start milling on 9/11 and paving on 9/18. All work will be done in the evening.
