Board of Education, section 2-115 – It was decided to recommend the following changes to the full commission:

Drop At each Town Election the number of candidates of any one political party elected to serve on the Board of Education shall not exceed a bare majority of the number of candidates to be seated.

Minority Representation on Board of Education should follow provisions of CGS 9-167(a). Eric in dissent.

Board of Finance, Section 2-120 Recommend to full Commission adding language that allows Full Board of Finance to appoint members to fill open seats.

Discussed Differences in Tem Limits in existing Charter/Ordinances applied to various Boards and Commissions:

Section 4-80 Building Appeals Board – 2 consecutive 5 year terms

Section 4-60 Board of Ethics, 2 consecutive – 4 year terms

Ordinance Economic Development Commission – 2 consecutive 3 year terms

Ordinance Self-Funded Health Insurance Fund Committee – 2 consecutive 3 year terms

Section 4-110 Library Board of Trustees – No Trustee shall serve for more than 9 consecutive years except to complete a term for which the Trustee shall have been elected, and thereafter said Trustee shall be ineligible to serve as Trustee for a period of 2 years.

Having No further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:30pm.
