The council held the public hearing for the purpose of public comments on the proposed rate increase for the Fairfield Hills Water System.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Jay Mattegat, 1 Sealand Drive, and Linda Manganaro, 160 Brushy Hill Road, representing Nunnawauk Meadows. Nunnawauk Meadows has 134 units with 150 elderly and disabled residents. Ms. Manganaro explained the average annual income of the residents is \$16,000, and many are receiving rental subsidies from the federal government. The proposed water rate increase would be about \$3,200 a year. This will significantly affect their budget as their income is derived only from the residents rent. She is asking for consideration of a smaller rate increase. Mr. Mattegat echoed Ms. Manganaro's comments.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further comments, the hearing was adjourned at 8:20pm.
