Email 1 of 2 (Sept 11, 2015):

I reviewed and here are my comments. Some are superficial and a couple are more meaningful:

1. Under the definition of Cancellation and False Alarm-It mentions Fire Department-Do we need to loop in FD on this. I think their position will be no fines for false alarms etc.
2. Under False Alarm- Reasonable should be changed to reasonably (2) twice
3. Late Fee \$25.00-Should we define what a "late fee" is? When it is imposed?
4. 104-8 Fines Subsection D the word: flexibility should be the word instead of flexibility
5. Not sure about the language in 104-8 B 2: What does caused by an on-site employee??
6. Suspension of Response: Could it be 20 minutes notice provided before PC hearing instead of 30 days.

I had time to review further; so please find my additional comments. Thanks for the opportunity to review and comment!!

1. Perhaps we should eliminate FD references all together. They have abilities under the Fire Marshall codes to get things done!!!
2. Under Suspension of Response Definition: Add to key holder: "or responsible person".
3. Just a thought: Eliminate the Fee structure from the ordinance and make a parallel resolution outlining the fee structure.
4. 104.3 E- . . . sufficient cause for refusal "or revocation".
5. 104.7 D . . . may require an alarm user to remove "or modify"
6. When an alarm user issued a fine; we need to specify when the fine should be paid. Usually within 10 days!!
7. There is a definition of Runaway Alarm; Need to state in the ordinance that if the police shift commander determines a Runaway Alarm, he/she can temporarily suspend response to that alarm.
8. Final comment: The Registration year is July1 through June 30. If the ordinance is passed in Nov. I would request that the Registration Period be changed to Jan 1 to Dec 31. I can start anew Jan 1 2016 with this modification.
