APPLICATION BY THE TOWN OF NEWTOWN PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE TOWN OF NEWTOWN ZONING REGULATIONS AT ARTICLE V, SECTION 5 CONCERNING OPEN SPACE CONSERVATION SUBDIVISIONS, AS CONTAINED IN CERAIN DOCUMENTS ENTITLED "NEWTOWN ZONING REGULATION AMENDMENT OF OCSC SECTION 15" AND "ARTICLE V OPEN SPACE CONSERVATION SUBDIVISIONS" DATED SEPTEMBER 30, 2011

The hearing was opened at 7:50 p.m.

Ms. Dean read the call for the hearing.

Mr. Benson advised the Commission that he had been in touch with the Conservation Commission for their suggestions regarding open space. He is working on the regular regulations to be sure they are compatible with these and will seek the Town Attorney's approval.

Mary Wilson, Whippoorwill Road, member of the Conservation Commission joined the discussion. She thanked the Commission for working on this matter.

Deborra Zukowski, 4 Cornfield Ridge Road member of the Fairfield Hills Master Plan Review Committee would like to see ballfields scattered throughout the town. There is a need to plan for the future.

Mr. Benson will update the Commission at the next meeting after talking with the Town Attorney.

Ms. Dean updated the Commission on the housing section. She asked for help regarding the study for high density and incentive housing. Mr. Benson will assist, adding that the website is being updated so it will give more site availability. The data should be ready for the next meeting.

LAND USE AGENCY DIRECTOR'S COMMENTS

Mr. Benson advised that he had received calls from two property owners in Hawleyville wanting to extend the design district to include their property.

Ms. Dean advised that there is a possibility that the meeting scheduled for November 17, 2011 will be cancelled.

As a result of the referendum about Fairfield Hills housing Mr. Bloom made a motion to withdraw the open application for affordable housing at Fairfield Hills. Seconded by Mr. Poulin. The motion was approved unanimously. Ms. Dean would like to discuss affordable housing at the next meeting.

The Commission said they need to decide what areas of Fairfield Hills should be deeded open space so they are protected. Conservation Commission has been working on this.

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Mr. Bloom made a motion to approve the Minutes of September 15, 2011 as revised. Seconded by Mr. Pozek. The vote was approved unanimously.
