MANDATORY REFERRAL

MANDATORY REFERRAL UNDER CGS 8-24 FROM THE BOROUGH OF NEWTOWN FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE BOROUGH OF NEWTOWN ZONING REGULATIONS AT SECTION 6.07A AND 6.05B2 PERTAINING TO SIGNS IN RESIDENTIAL ZONES.

Don Mitchell, Esq., Attorney for the Borough explained how the proposal came about. There have been some discussions about separating Main Street from the rest of the Borough.

Ms. Dean wondered if signs would be needed if buildings were clearly numbered.

After a brief discussion on the matter Ms. Dean made a motion to support the application of the Borough. Seconded by Mr. Mulholland. The vote was unanimous.
