- a) Contract for the purchase of Walton Beach: MOTION made by Randy Hummel to accept the contract for the purchase of Walton Beach in the amount of \$155,000. Seconded by Gwen Schiada. All in favor. Motion carries.
- b) Breakwater Rehabilitation Project: The design and specifications are not complete. The RFP still needs to be sent out.
- c) Award Trash Contract: MOTION made by Greg Dotson to award the Trash Collection Contract to Southern Maryland Recycling with a three year base contract with a possible 1 year renewal up to two consecutive years with the total annual fee per household is \$145.20. Seconded by Ken Wilcox. All in favor.
- d) Award Contract for the re-writing of the North Beach Design Standards. MOTION made by Mike Benton to award the contract to E. Phillip McCormick in the amount of \$21,000.00. Seconded by Ken Wilcox. Abstention from Greg McNeil. Contract passes.

- a) Ordinance 11-04: An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance 10-05 which completely prohibits Boats, RV's and other recreation vehicles from parking on Town right of ways. This Ordinance was introduced and it will be voted on at the July meeting.
- b) Ordinance 11-05: FY 2012: MOTION made by Randy Hummel to pass FY 2010 as presented. Seconded Greg McNeil. All in favor. Motion carries.
- c) Emergency Ordinance 11-07: An Emergency Ordinance accepting the Amendment to the Local Insurance Trust Agreement: MOTION made by Randy Hummel to approve the Ordinance as an Emergency. Seconded by Ken Wilcox. All in favor. Motion carries. MOTION made by Ken Wilcox to adopt Emergency Ordinance 11-07. Seconded by Greg Dotson. All in favor.
