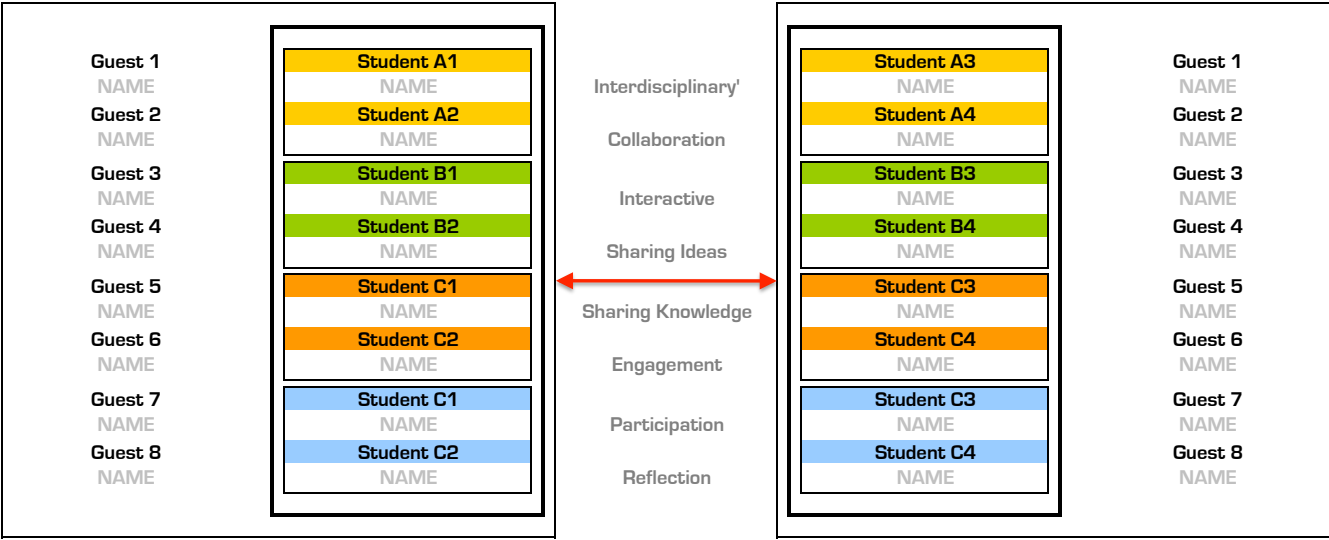

03:45 - 04:30	<b>Exercise 1: Recording Places and Events</b>	_ Each group should print two site plans of the town of North Beach (Define Scale). With post-it notes of different colors, identify: _ Map 1 - Important historical and current active places. Which are the most important places in the town? Categorize them from 1 to 3 by their importance and mark them with a different post-it color. _ Map 2 - What other activities/events take place in what other sites? Identify and discuss them. _ Engage in a conversation about how these places and events inform the design of the master plan. Think about connectivity between these events/places.
04:30 - 05:15	<b>Exercise 2: The Future</b>	_ Each group should print one site plan of the town of North Beach (Define Scale). Have a discussion about what the community and designers think the future of the town should be. Try to identify: _ Future needs/activities _ Future locations of those needs / activities _ Identify the importance for each of the needs / activities / sites _ Ask yourself what does the actual community wants to be in the future and what does it need to get there - physically, economically, socially, culturally, etc?

Think about the future plans and how to get there - what events and places should have priority, which economical, social and cultural events/places/activities should be prioritized.
