NORTH BEACH FRIDAY NIGHT FARMERS' MARKET OPERATING RULES

The North Beach Friday Night Farmers' Market is sponsored by the Town of North Beach.

The following rules apply to the market for the 2014 season:

- A. The purpose of the Market is to provide fresh produce to local residents and support local farmers.
- B. The Market will operate on Fridays and will be open from 6:00 pm 9:00 pm, or until they sell out starting Friday, May 2, 2014 to Friday, October 3, 2014. The Market is located on 5th Street between Bay & Chesapeake Avenues, North Beach, Maryland 20714, weather permitting. Call Town Hall on Friday if you suspect the market may be canceled. All effort will be made to send cancellation of the market at the earliest time possible. **The town reserves the right to accept or reject any application without explanation or comment.** The market is limited to farm produced items, food products and local wineries.
- C. Each farmer must submit applications to Town Hall prior to selling. Town Hall will maintain a list of approved farmers, and if necessary, a waiting list (numbered and dated) of interested farmers.
- D. All vegetables, fruits, herbs, tree nuts, flowers and plants sold at the Market must be grown in Maryland. All farmers agree to on-site inspections of their growing operations.
- E. In 2014, there will be no cost to participate. Each space is approximately one truck or van length long, with standard 10'x10' table or covered booth space.
- F. Farmers agree to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local governmental laws and health regulations and obtain any and all necessary licenses and permits and provide documentation of such compliance. Proof of insurance may also be required.
- G. Set-up for the Market begins at 5:00 pm and selling begins at exactly 6:00 pm. The market manager shall open the market officially with the sound of a bell.
- H. Farmers are expected to set-up and sell on all market days, unless otherwise agreed. If an absence is unavoidable, producers must phone Town Hall as soon as possible.
- I. Farmers are to display a sign identifying the name and location of their farm. They must also display a price for each item for sale.
- J. Farmers are required to maintain their stands in a neat and orderly fashion and are responsible for removing all debris from their stall area at the end of each market day.

- K. Farmers must cheerfully comply with all requests from town staff, and all vendors are required to operate their stands in a safe manner. Farmers are required to make immediate safety changes when directed to do so by the town staff. All vans, trucks, tailgates, trailers, awnings, canopies, and popup tents must be properly secured for safety.
- L. Farmers agree that their names may be used for publicity purposes. Farmers also agree to cooperate in occasional business and customer surveys.
