Take steps to avoid "Identity Theft" by shredding documents that contain your personal information and/or account information. Calvert County offers FREE shred events every month. Always ask for the full name of the person calling and a call back number before sharing any information. ALL valid companies will readily give this information to you upon request. Check the number online to confirm it is a valid call and is going to the company indicated. Then, call the company back. When in doubt, don't give your info out!
