It's VACATION time! As many folks make their way to North Beach for vacation, we, the residents of North Beach often go elsewhere for vacation. Remember, when you go on vacation, a few tips to keep your property safe; Use timers to have lights come on in various rooms at various times, to give the appearance someone is home. Timers or dusk to dawn porch lights are also great to have. A porch light on 24/7 is a sure sign to a thief that no one is home. Stop newspaper delivery or have a neighbor pick up your papers. Nothing says no one is home more than multiple days' worth of newspapers scattered in front of your home. An important asset in keeping your home safe is your neighbors. Let your closest neighbors know you will be away and for how long. If they can, have them park in front of your home or in your driveway to give the appearance someone is home. Let them know if you expect anyone to stop by to water plants, feed the fish, etc. Otherwise, ask them to say something if they see something! Ask them to Call 911 immediately if they see anything suspicious at your home while you are away.
