In April of 2016, the Sheriff's Office handled 193 calls for service in North Beach. This is equal to the 193 calls in March 2016.

(In April of 2015, the Sheriff's Office handled 193 calls for service in North Beach.)

93 calls were self-initiated (patrol checks, follow-up investigations, etc)

100 calls were received by other means (citizens, alarm companies, etc)
