Re: Sheriff's Office Report-North Beach

In September of 2016, the Sheriff's Office handled 178 calls for service in North Beach. This is down from the 193 calls in August 2016.

(In September of 2015, the Sheriff's Office handled 144 calls for service in North Beach.)

Call Breakdown for September 2016:

78 calls were self-initiated (patrol checks, follow-up investigations, etc)

100 calls were received by other means (citizens, alarm companies, etc)

Of the 178 calls, we handled:

- 2 CDS Violations (1 Heroin, 1 Cocaine PWID) Closed by Arrest
- 2 DOP
 - o Items thrown around store at Fastop (Under Investigation)
 - o Rear vehicle window, 3rd St. (Under Investigation)
- 2 Thefts
 - Shed Burglary Union Church (Closed by Arrest)
 - Stolen Vehicle Dayton Ave, Keys left in UNLOCKED Veh. (Under Investigation, Has Been Recovered)
- 1 Heroin Overdose Non-Fatal
