Discussion regarding non payment for a garden and the \$25 surcharge imposed by the town for a bad check.

Meeting of all Boards with Planning Board: This was an opportunity for all boards to hear what other boards are working on. Of interest to the Ag Comm would be ordinances regarding stock piling of raw materials, accessory Structures, signage, wetlands buffer, conservation easements, any other changes affecting agriculture. Farmers Market was proposed and the response was enthusiastic.

Farmers Market: further discussion including nutrient management planning, parking options, grant \$, community support.

School Greenhouse: Lisa reported that there is now a paid manager. On Thursdays he is there after 3 pm and would welcome visitors if any of us want to stop in. Bob Hamilton has been instrumental in the success of the outdoor gardens (square foot gardening) and the greenhouse projects. The greenhouse will shut down in the coldest months to conserve on fuel costs.

Action Items: Cindy follow up with gardeners regarding lost items and check with boy scouts regarding missing hose. Cindy follow up with Jan on pursuing collection of delinquent community garden money. B.Burns follow up on mowing by town at garden.
