Purpose: The purpose of this meeting is to meet in non-public to discuss merit increases for employees who are not covered by a collective bargaining agreement and to receive updates on the formation of the negotiation team for represented employees.

2. First Public Comment Session

Public Comment is an opportunity for residents to ask questions, request information and make comments on issues facing the Town. Individuals ordinarily will be given not more than three (3) minutes to speak, and people who have already spoken will be asked to wait until everyone has had the chance to speak once. The total time devoted to this agenda item is fifteen (15) minutes. Individuals who are not able to speak will be given first opportunity to speak during the Second Public Comment Session at the end of the Meeting.

3. New Business

3.1. Non-Public Session I: Pursuant to RSA 91-A:3, II(a) (the dismissal, promotion, or compensation of any public employee or the disciplining of such employee, or the investigation of any charges against him or her, unless the employee affected (1) has a right to a meeting and (2) requests that the meeting be open, in which case the request shall be granted).

4. Any Other Item that may legally come before the Board

The Board reserves the right to take action on any item relative to the prudential administration of the Town's affairs which circumstances may require.

5. Second Public Comment Session

6. Adjournment

A brief "non-meeting" will follow adjournment to discuss strategies for upcoming collective bargaining negotiations with the N.H. Professional Fire Fighters Association. See, RSA 91-A:2, I ("Meeting" shall also not include: (a) Strategy or negotiations with respect to collective bargaining).
