## Budget Committee Minutes

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13 Wednesday, December 11, 2013 Town Hall

## 1415 Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance 7:05pm

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Final Review Town FY15 Proposed Budget: Mr. Stanton made a motion to recommend to
 the Town of North Hampton an operating budget, not including special warrants, of \$6,129,130
 for FY15. Mr. Walzak second. Discussion. Default budget is \$6,123,225.

20 Motion carried 7-1.

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22 **Town Warrant Articles:** Mr. Apple presented a draft of the warrant articles.

- 23 #1. Terms for elected office
- 24 #2. Municipal Complex Project overview of project given.
- 25 #3. Operating Budget
- 26 #4. Road Resurfacing, \$250.0K. \$30.0K from Capital Reserve, \$220.0 from taxation.
- 27 Discussion. Historical expenditures requested.
- #5. Police Cruiser Purchase, withdrawal of \$47.0K from Police Revolving Detail Fund.
- Discussion. Balance is \$89.0K. Chief Page expects to have \$115.0K at time of withdrawal and expect \$50.0-60.0K per year to be put into the fund.
- 31 #6. Portable Radio Purchase, withdrawal of \$18.1K from Detail Fund.
- 32 *#*7. Roof Mounted Lights Purchase, withdrawal of \$10.4K from Detail Fund.
- 33 #8. Contribution to Mosquito Control Capital Reserve Fund, \$75.0K through taxation. 11/30
- balance is \$176.3K, it was decided to double-check this figure.
- #9. Contribution to Health Benefits Stabilization Capital Reserve Fund, \$25.0K through taxation.
  Balance is \$90.8K, \$30.0K to be withdrawn for FY15 budget.
- #10. Contribution to Earned Time Settlement Capital Reserve Fund, \$10.0K through taxation.
   Balance is \$20.3K.
- 39 #11. Establish an IT Capital Reserve Account, \$35.0K through taxation for future server and
- 40 other technology replacement and maintenance. Mr. Hamilton expressed concern over having
- 41 maintenance issue in a warrant versus the operating budget. Discussion.

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- 43 Mr. Stanton explained the CIP committee's view and stated he thought the amount of \$35.0K
  44 was low. Discussion.
- 46 Mr. Peck stated that the proliferation of these kinds of funds takes away flexibility to add to the 47 Undesignated Fund Balance. He requested a schedule of all fund balances and to look at what 48 percent the Undesignated Fund Balance is versus all the other fund balances. Discussion.
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  50 Mr. Stanton suggested a warrant for building maintenance whether or not the municpal complex
  51 is approved. Discussion.
- 53 Mr. Miller asked if there should be a warrant for revaluation, cost of which is approximately 54 \$80.0K. Discussion.
- 56 Mr. Miller suggested a warrant next year to start saving for revaluation.

58 Municipal Complex Project Update: Mr. Apple provided to the committee the presentation 59 he is giving around town to explain the reasoning behind and the cost of a new municipal 60 complex. Conceptual plans were laid out and the approximate price is \$6.1M. Financing and 61 architectural plans are being finalized. 62

64 Mr. Hamilton moved to accept the minutes of 11/20 as modified by Mr. Stanton, Mr. Peck 65 second, motion carried 8-0-1.

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Ms. Kilroy asked for line 20 to be amended on the 12/4 minutes. Mrs. Allen moved to acceptthe minutes as amended, Mr. Stanton second, motion carried 9-0.

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New Business: Mr. Stanton made a motion to reconsider approval of the town operating
 budget so Mr. Golden would be able to cast his vote, Mr. Hamilton second, motion carried 9-0.
 Mr. Stanton moved to recommend to the Town of North Hampton an operating budget, not to
 include special warrants, of \$6,129,130 for FY15. Motion carried 8-1.
