12 13 14	Wednesday, November 5, 2014 Town Hall

20 21 22 23 24	Nominations for Budget Committee vacancy The Chair announced that only one volunteer had come forward for the open seat, Mr. Jon Rineman. Discussion regarding Mr. Rineman's qualifications/experience on Budget Committee, School Board and Select Board.		
25 26	Mrs. Schmitz made a motion to nominate Mr. Rineman for the Budget Committee vacancy, Mr. Garnett seconded. Motion carried 7-0.		
27 28 29 30 31	Town Year End Review and Default Calculation - P. Apple Mr. Apple discussed the Town financials and default budget for the coming year. The FY16 Default Budget is \$6,385,787, \$246,355 over the FY15approved budget or a 4% increase.		
32 33 34 35	First Review of Town Proposed FY16 Budget The Proposed Budget is \$6,459,681, \$73,894 above the Default Budget or 1.2% higher than Default.		
36 37	Proposed Budget is 5.2% higher than FY15 approved Budget.		
38 39 40 41 42	Two areas of the budget had significant increases. First, an increase in health insurance rate for both the represented and unrepresented employees, a GMR of 24%, because claims have more than doubled in the last year. Second, municipal contributions to the NHRS will increas July 1, 2015.		

- Discussion. Mr. Golden requested Mr. Apple research the five year history of claims to try to
 piece together whether this was an anomoly or a pattern.
- Mr. Sununu advised the committee regarding contributions to NHRS and to continue to expectincreases every two years as the fund cannot cover liabilities.
- Chief Page discussed the newly formed Director of Public Safety position and the training he feltnecessary for Public Safety.
- 51 52 Mr. Stanton stated that the CBA's built in a 3% increase in the Default Budget and there was a 53 need to focus on training, training that had been cut in prior budgets, and that along with the 54 group training came charges to overtime.
- 56 Both Mr. Hamilton and Mrs. Allen had stated reservations regarding taking a 5.2% increase to 57 the taxpayer with COLA at 1.7% and median raises at 3%.
- 59 Mrs. Allen requested the committee to read through the Town Budget Book and to send 60 questions to her by Friday, November 14.
- Mrs. Allen requested the committee to read through the NHS Budget Book and to send
 questions regarding the school budget by Sunday, November 9 in the evening so the SAU would
 have questions Monday morning before the holiday.
