John Kollmorgen and Dickie Garnett 13 were absent. 14 15 Ms. Swank said the business of the day is to prioritize the FY2017 capital projects. She had sent everyone charts for each department and asked for any corrections or additions. 16 17 Mr. Stanton noted that the Town Hall repair project had been agreed upon for a three-18 year maintenance warrant article, and the committee agreed that should be slated for 19 \$25,000 per year until there is a better estimate from an expert in historic restoration of clapboards. 20 21 22 Mr. Apple said the cost estimates had just come in for the Fifth Municipal Facilities 23 Committee's presentation to the Select Board on Monday night, September 28. He 24 reviewed those estimates with the Committee. 25 26 As prioritization began, Mr. Stanton shared his list as a starting point, saying he chose his 27 priorities based on safety of citizens and employees. The Committee discussed each 28 project and came to agreement on all, with the Municipal Campus being the top priority 29 once again in this CIP report. Ms. Swank said the draft of the CIP report is ready to be 30 delivered to all Committee members to read prior to the next meeting.
