NORTH HAMPTON PLANNING BOARD Work Session Monday, April 17, 2006 at 6:30pm

Gerry Billadeau, President of the CCE Homeowners Association was present to discuss possible changes to the zoning ordinances to establish specifications to utility companies to restore roadsides to original states after work is completed.

The Board concurred that the maintenance and restoration of the roadwork does not fall under the jurisdiction of the Planning Board.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of February 22, 2006 and all were in favor.

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of April 3, 2006 with amendments and all were in favor.

The March 20, 2006 minutes were tabled for a full quorum.

The Board reviewed the latest revision of the Wireless Communication Facilities amendments.

Ms. Robinson went over last year's contracts between the Town and Rockingham Planning Commission.

- CIP and CFS contract
- Master Plan contract

There are 43 hours remaining on the contract. Ms. Robinson requested that the Board prioritize projects they would like to accomplish with the remaining time.
