#### 2. Program Overviews/Registrations Reviewed

- Coates Hoop Camp has largest percentage of child registration from Hampton with advanced classes having 9-15 children signed up per session (this provides a healthy 1:10 or 1:7 ratio of coaches to children)
- Surfing –Classes start July 10<sup>th</sup> with 5 individuals signed up
- Two sessions of Heatwave Field Hockey will be scheduled, one each for: 6-7 and 8-9 yr olds
- Tennis #'s look great for all sessions. Pay incentive for families with multchild participants is happening: if multiple children from one family take 2 sessions at full cost, any session there after, receives a reduced rate

## 3. Summer Rec Camp Updates

- 66 Resident Children are registered for part-time camp.
- Full-time Registrations are as follows by week: #1=25; #2= 28; #3=22; #4=27; #5=22.
- Little Nippers has maxed out registration for the first session with 15 registered preschoolers. So far, 8 children are signed up for the second session.
- There have been no non-resident registrations to date
- Total registrations are slightly down for date. Last year numbers were at 130, but all were for part-time, as there was no full-time option.
