My husband, Wallace P. Hale, and I received a Letter from NH DOT written and signed by Melodie A. Esterberg, P.E. Chief of Design Services dated October 24, 2014 regarding a scheduled Bridge replacement project in the town of North Hampton on US 1 over the Boston Maine Railroad.

According to the calendar Spring has arrived but I am wondering if it has in North Hampton after all the snowstorms. I am also wondering if any proposed surveying has been done or completed. This surveying is going to cause an effect on our property between Lafayette Road and North Road East, North Hampton, NH which is the reason we got a letter from you..

My husband, Wallace P. Hale, passed away in Colorado on June 29, 2014. Each of us had Trusts. Recently Attorney Al Casassa of Hampton completed transferring the 21.3 acres on Lafayette Road and North Road East, North Hampton, Tax Map/Lot #161-1174 according to your letter (but our 2013 bill says Map 17, Lot 98, Pg- Line 0137-06) and my most recent Warranty Deed that Al Casassa recently drew up mentions "shown on the Town Map, North Hampton, NH dated April 1, 1974." Our accountant has our 2014 tax bill so I cannot check it but it usually remains the same for a few years.

My father. Joshua F. Drake, was the owner of 148 Lafayette Road, North Hampton before it got sold at least twice before it was purchased by a man who is turning the buildings into a furniture store. Enclosed is a photo of a "stone marker" that I retrieved from the DRAKE genealogy that my husband compiled after he became a genealogy "buff" in his retirement years. The reason I am sending a copy of this this letter and also one of the "stone marker" to whomever was mentioned in your letter to us in October is primarily, right now anyway, my concern as to what may or may not become of this "stone marker". I would really appreciate it if the new owner would keep it on his property if it is going to have to be "moved" by the NH DOT. I am going to ask Wendy Chase of the North Hampton Planning Board to forward a copy of this letter to him. If I remember correctly, I believe there is a NH law concerning the movement of such markers. There used to be a much wider piece of lawn on the Lafayette Road side of this "stone marker" but over the period of all these many years since it was erected in 1927 some of it has eroded and much of it got taken away by the snowplows. I remember my father saying there was supposedly a "gutter" in front of it.


The letter from NH CDOT does not mention what is going to be done to Lafayette Road but I cannot believe that very dangerous curve coming from Portsmouth is going to remain "as is ". # THE DRAKE BOULDER



This is the boulder in front of the Drake House in North Hampton, New Hampshire that was placed there by Clifford Drake in 1927 and reads as follows:

"This boulder marks the site of the home of Colonel Abraham Drake, December 4 1751 to August 1 1781. Captain of the Horse in the French and Indian Wars, fought at Crown Point, 1775/76. One of the first to take arms in the Revolution. Lieut. Colonel in 3<sup>rd</sup> New Hampshire Volunteers, commanded by General George Washington to attend Councils of War. Member of Provincial Congress of Exeter, New Hampshire, 1775. Colonel in New Hampshire 1776-77, marched with his company drawing artillery with Oxen from here to Saratoga, to intercept General Burgoyne and was present at his surrender".

- B) The wiring and piping will be removed from the 7.5 ton condenser. The condenser will be moved to the front of the pad with the crane, about 4ft. from the original position and away from the roof line. Your electrician must extend the wire from the disconnect box to the condenser. The refrigerant piping will be laid on cement blocks from the side of the building to the condenser. Refrigerant will be added and the system started.

# 2015 | LITTLE RIVER SAMPLING

Dear Mr. Apple,

Since 2008, FBE has assisted the Town of North Hampton with identifying non-point sources of bacteria to the Little River. Through these assessments and separate watershed planning projects, remediation efforts have been prioritized and specific sources of bacteria to the Little River have been identified and addressed. Despite the multiple successes of previous projects, more work needs to be done. Non-point source pollution is an ongoing problem that cannot be addressed through a single water quality project. Continuous effort is required as new sources of bacteria arise from aging infrastructure and increasing population.

We believe that the following tasks are important to the successful continuation of a water quality assessment and bacteria source tracking study in the Little River watershed. We understand that we will be working collaboratively with the Town of North Hampton throughout this process. The tasks below outline our technical approach for completing the components of the project. We have budgeted \$9,969 for the Scope of Work to include the following tasks. All project costs will be counted as required match towards the Little River Watershed Based Plan Implementation Project (grant project with NHDES). The current match requirement for 2015 is \$10,000 for water quality monitoring and assessment projects.

# TASK 1: Project Coordination

May-December 2015

FBE will provide project management activities as specified in this proposal. This will include tracking project tasks and ensuring completion of tasks within budget. Laura Diemer will serve as project manager and primary point of contact for this project.

# TASK 2: Watershed Monitoring

May-October 2015

In 2013 and 2014, FBE sampled fixed locations throughout the Little River during low tide to assess bacteria concentrations under different weather conditions at different times of year. It is recommended that this sampling be continued to assess changes in bacteria concentrations and to identify new "hotspots" of bacterial contamination. FBE proposes to sample the six established sampling locations in the Little River watershed on four sample dates (two under wet and two under dry weather conditions).

DELIVERABLE Brief memo summarizing Task 2 results.

TIMEFRAME Sample May-October, 2015; Memo by November 15, 2015

# TASK 3: Septic System Outreach Workshop

July-August 2015

In 2013, FBE developed a septic system database for all parcels in the Little River watershed. This database and accompanying memo serve as the starting point to develop a comprehensive septic system program in North Hampton. FBE proposes to conduct the following tasks as a follow-up to the creation of this database:

- 1. Research septic system ordinance options for the Town of North Hampton. Other municipalities in New Hampshire and Maine are faced with similar bacteria issues and have reacted by developing local ordinances such as septic system pump-out ordinances. FBE would compile these examples into a memo and provide a list of options that could be utilized in North Hampton.
- 2. Develop a targeted public outreach campaign for the residents of the Little River watershed. This campaign would target neighborhoods previously identified in routine water quality sampling and would likely include the following:
  - a. Development and mailing of an educational flyer focused on septic system maintenance; and
  - b. Organization of a public workshop on water quality and the importance of maintaining septic systems.

DELIVERABLE: Memo summarizing Task 3 activities (ordinance research, outreach event), copy of septic system flyer TIMEFRAME Ordinance memo by July 2015; flyer and workshop by August 2015; summary memo by September 2015

# PROPOSED BUDGET

As outlined in Table 1, the base project budget will not exceed \$9,969 for the Scope of Work outlined in this proposal. As indicated above, all project funds will count as match for the NHDES watershed assistance grant received by the Town of North Hampton.
