Selectmen's Meeting Non-public Session March 25, 1999

The non-public session of the Board of Selectmen was convened on March 25th and was called to order by the Chair, George Lagassa, at 1:00pm. Those present included Jack Steiner, Allen Hines, (Selectmen), Tim Harned, Henry Fuller, Richard Betcher (Water Commissioners) and Russell McAllister (Town Administrator). The purpose of the meeting was to interview those appraisal firms that had responded to a Town issued request for qualifications. The appraisal firm selected will be conducting a revaluation of the Hampton Water Works. The revaluation is in response to Article XIV of the March 1998 Town meeting wherein the;

"Town raise[d] and appropriate[d] the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to fund the cost of legal and technical services associated with the acquisition of that portion of the Hampton Water Works Company's plant and property which the Selectmen judge to be suitable for establishing a municipal Water Company?"

The interview of four appraisal firms was completed and the meeting adjourned at 5:00pm.
