I. Call to Order

Chair Creighton called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m. Also present were Selectmen Gould and Salomon, Interim Town Administrator Philip Munck and Barry Cox of the Local Government Center's Recruitment Service. Mr. Munck served as the Recording Secretary for this session.

II. Selectmen Items

- a. <u>Bid Procedure</u>. The Board approved sealed bids for the Highway Garage being publicly opened and read at an advertised time by Town staff and forwarded to the Highway Superintendent, Building Inspector and Town Administrator for review and recommendation to the Board at its regular meeting.
- b. <u>Bass Beach Trash Container</u>. Mr. Munck reported that he had left a telephone message on the subject but that it was the recommendation of Highway Superintendent Strout and himself that no container be placed because recent Town experience indicated that such containers exacerbate the problem rather than helping. He also noted that all of the property in question is owned by the N.H. Department of Transportation down to the high water mark.

Moved by Mr. Gould, seconded by Mr. Salomon that the Board enter non-public session to discuss setting up interviews for candidates to fill the Town Administrator's position. Roll Call: Yeas: all, Nays: none.

Mr. Munck and Mr. Cox were present. The Board discussed the top candidates, their schedules and requested Mr. Cox to set up interviews. Mr. Cox discussed some of the procedures recommended by LGC for interviewing candidates.
