Agenda Item 1:

Mr. Fuller called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Agenda Item 2:

Agenda Item 3:

Aquarion.

Carl McMorran provided an update on several issues.

- a) Carl distributed a handout summarizing the Aquarion 2014 Capital Projects and their current status. There was no discussion.
- b) Carl provided a status on customer metering. It is almost done and will be completed by the end of 2014.

- c) Carl started a discussion of the Well Owner Response Policy (WORP) for Aquarion production wells 17, 18 and 19. Aquarion wishes to discontinue monitoring of homeowner wells covered in the WORP. This action requires agreement from the NH PUC. Carl stated only 1/3 of the original participants are still in the WORP. The Commission countered that the Commission was open to discussion of the WORP but that the Commission must agree to any changes. It was agreed the DES would review the impact data prepared by Aquarion. It was also agreed the Commission and Aquarion would work together to update and survey the original WORP participants regarding if they wished to remain in or drop out of the WORP. Aquarion have sent out letters to WORP participants stating failure to reply indicated a wish to drop out of the WORP. The Commission indicated that was not acceptable and more of an outreach to participants was required.

Agenda Item 4:

Nancy Monaghan regarding the Hampton Rod & Gun Club and lead testing at the site.

Nancy provided an extensive overview of the issue of lead shot being shot over and into the wetlands. Further, there is a wetland area closing the pistol/rifle range. This has led to a review of the complete site.
