

Meeting Minutes Town of North Hampton Zoning Board of Adjustment Tuesday, August 2, 2016 at 6:30pm North Hampton Public Library, 237A Atlantic Avenue North Hampton, NH 03862

These Minutes were prepared as a reasonable summary of the essential content of the Meeting, not as a transcription. All exhibits mentioned, or incorporated by reference, in these Minutes are a part of the official Case Record and available for inspection at the Town Offices.

Chair Gordon called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm.

Pursuant to notice duly and timely posted, a special public meeting of the North Hampton, NH Zoning Board of Adjustment met was held on Tuesday, August 2, 2016, at 6:30 pm in the Roberta Craig Room of the North Hampton Public Library, 237A Atlantic Avenue, North Hampton, NH 03862.

The purpose of the special meeting was to consider the engagement of legal counsel for advice as to whether the Board has jurisdiction to hear Case No. 16:01, the Appeal of James A.C. Jones from a Cease and Desist Order issued by the North Hampton Code Enforcement Officer regarding activities conducted by the applicant at 206 Lafayette Road in said town.

Present at the meeting were all five principal members of the Board: Charles Gordon, Chair; Phelps Fullerton, Vice-Chair; George Lagassa; Mark Janos; and Jonathan Pinette. Also present was alternate member Robin Reid.

Recalling that the Board, at its previous meeting in public hearing on June 28, 2016 had tabled this case after considering but not reaching a conclusion on the question of its jurisdiction to hear the case, the Board took note of Mr. Jones's timely filed subsequent request for a rehearing.

After deliberation, on motions by Lagassa, seconded by Janos, the Board unanimously voted to

(2) direct the Chair to contact Attorney Peter Loughlin of Portsmouth, NH (alternatively, Attorney Charles Tucker of Exeter, NH) to secure such engagement; and

(1) engage legal counsel for advice and guidance on the jurisdictional question referred to above;

(3) authorize and Direct the Chair and Board member Janos (alternatively, Board member Lagassa) together to meet with the attorney to be engaged to present the legal issue and seek counsel's advice thereon, to be delivered (insofar as possible) before the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board on August 23, 2016.

The meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
