Permanent School Building Project Committee activities-First Selectman Mullane reported on a meeting with Natalie Pukas, Superintendent, requesting the Board of Selectmen helping to make a choice on which building project proposal best for the Town. Mr. Mullane was asked if the Town had any use for the Middle School/High School buildings. The Board of Education continues to have security concerns, especially in the tunnel.
