- 8. Call of Town Meeting
 - **DUI Grant FY 2007**Selectman Mullane made a motion to request an additional appropriation in the amount of \$87,975, seconded by Selectman Peterson, carrying. 3-0
 - CCM Electric Co-op-Selectman Mullane reported appeal process is over. Results not yet known.
 - Attorney Accounts added appropriation-Of the \$40,000 original budget for the line item only \$4256 remains. We have outstanding invoices from Day, Berry & Howard in the amount of \$11,563, and O'Brien Shaftner in the amount of \$8198. Largest cost to date is the Route 2 modifications appeal of approximately \$23,339. Selectman Hescock questioned continuing appeal process and asked if a transfer of funds could be done from other attorney line items or separate into

two requests one for Route 2 and one for normal business. No consensus could be reached by the Board. Hescock could not support the request. Selectman Mullane made a motion to request a \$40,000 additional appropriation, seconded by Selectman Peterson, carrying. 2-1 with Selectman Hescock opposed.

- 1. Street Light Rebate-Appeal process has ended, we have not received final numbers for Town rebate.

- 3. Advertisement for Backhoe/Loader Sale-After general discussion, OK to advertise \$20,000 minimum bid.
