Thursday, May 12, 2015

Meeting Called to order: 5:30 pm.

Meeting Minutes: the meeting minutes for 4/23/15 were accepted with minor corrections. N. Corbin will make corrections and redistribute the final version.

- <u>Chairman:</u>
 - \$20,000 was authorized at Town Meeting to support the 250th celebration
 - The 250th Committee will receive a \$1200 donation from the company "Republic Services". The plan is to have the check received at an upcoming Board of Selectmen Meeting.
- Finance Committee:
 - Fund Raising:
 - *Tiered Fund Raising Effort:* Lorna presented her proposal for 3 different sets of Tiered funding. One for large corporations, one for small organizations and one for families. The Committee agreed that the tiered system was okay and to move forward using it.
 - *The Art Auction* with Lions Club on May 8 raised about \$200.
 - Budgets:
 - Lorna prepared a preliminary profits estimate from the various fund raising events. Total profit should be on the order of +\$87k. This included the Golf Tournament, 5K Road Race, Sponsored Street Banners, Cookbook, Commemorative Items, Tiered Fundraising and Yard Signs. To fine tune the estimates she needs a decision on the logo because it affects some costs.
 - A motion to accept Lorna's financial report was made by Cathy and seconded by Dave and passed unanimously.
- **Publicity/Marketing:**
 - *Website / Facebook* A printout of an initial design was presented. No decision regarding its acceptance was made at this time.
 - Logo Four additional designs prepared by the person working on the website were presented. Although they were nice, the general consensus was they were to elaborate to be used considering the cost for reproducing them on signage, banners and memorabilia. Tom made a motion to accept an earlier simple design presented at the last meeting by Lorna. It was seconded by Bob M. and passed unanimously.
 - *Commemorative Items* Lorna and her marketing team have selected 7 items to be available for sale with the 250th Logo. They are: a coin, pin, coffee mug, T-shirt, hat, jacket and Christmas ornament. She is looking for a vendor and pricing.

 - 250th Gala Ball Event (January 30, 2016) Linda Abusamra has been selected as the chairperson to organize the Gala. Linda Corbin's name has been forwarded Virginia for any assistance.
