 - Venue Looked into a variety of options. Decided to hold it at the Westborough Double
 Tree considering how well they did for the gala.
 - Music Investigated D-jays and bands. Their recommendation is a band hired through Wilson-Stevens Productions, which the 250th committee agrees with. Information on several band options will be forwarded to the 250th committee.
 - **Photo Booth** A contract was signed for having one at the event
 - **Tables & Seating** The color theme will be navy blue & gold. A centerpiece idea was shown; it was met with mixed opinions. It was recommended that several alternative

- centerpiece options be investigated. Target price for each centerpiece will be \$35 to \$50. Seating will be 10 per table.
- **Tickets** It was agreed that the tickets will sell for \$50 per person. At this time plan on 350 people attending. Andy will look into Event-Bright as a possible on-line purchasing option.
- Food Similar choices as last time. The committee requested a copy of the menu options.
- Advertising The owner of "Paint Circle" is considering volunteering her time to design a poster that would be distributed around town. The posters would be printed at Assabet Tech.
