The Northborough Board of Health will hold a public hearing pursuant to M.G.L. c. 111, § 150B to consider a request for a modification to the existing Site Assignment granted to Zecco, Inc. for a hazardous waste storage transfer facility located at 345 West Main Street, Northborough, MA 01532. The Applicant is Tradebe Treatment and Recycling of Northborough, LLC ("Tradebe").

The public hearing will take place at 6:00 p.m. on July 10, 2018 in the Selectmen's Meeting Room at Town Hall. This will replace the previously scheduled June 12, 2018 hearing which has been canceled.

Tradebe is proposing to modify the current Site Assignment in order to change from storage of about 40,000 gallons of hazardous waste in above-ground tanks with transfer off-site for treatment, recycling and disposal to a proposed 5-day Transfer Facility at which unopened containers will be transferred from one truck to another truck in a roofed containment area. There will be no consolidation, processing or outside storage. The facility will operate Monday through Sunday, from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tradebe transfers the containers by truck to off-site licensed treatment, recycling and disposal facilities. The Applicant is requesting that the Board of Health issue a modification of the Site Assignment to approve this change in operation.

The application for the modification is available for review during regular business hours at the Northborough Board of Health Office at Town Hall and at the Northborough Free Library, at 34 Main Street, Northborough, MA. Written comments will be accepted by the Northborough Board of Health in advance of the public hearing when delivered to the Board of Health at the

address listed above by no later than 11:00 a.m. on July 3, 2018. Any person wishing to intervene or participate in the public hearing must submit to the Board of Health a written petition for leave to intervene or participate at the address listed above no later than 11:00 a.m. on July 3, 2018. Such petitions should comply with eligibility criteria set forth in the MassDEP Solid Waste Regulations at 310 CMR 16.20(9)(a), copies of which are available at https://www.mass.gov/files/documents/2016/08/tx/310cmr16.pdf
