Change in CPC Membership:

- Leslie Harrison will now serve as the Planning Board's representative to the CPC.
- Kathleen Polanowicz is interested in filling the at-large vacancy and she will work with the Housing Authority to have them appoint someone as the HA representative.

White Cliffs Update from John Coderre, Town Administrator:

- Town is not paying for any costs related to remediation. Costs will be borne by present owner.
- Details of remediation work and Purchase & Sale Agreement are being worked out
- Town is not paying for any costs related to moving of historic features from Skinner to a storage facility. Costs will be borne by present owner.
- Board of Selectmen will be authorizing their Chairman to sign amendment to the Purchase & Sale Agreement when appropriately reviewed by town counsel and Town Administrator
- Town will have our own LSP on-site to review remediation process
- Site must be returned to usable parking lot with compacted soil
- Anticipate 2-3 week for remediation process
- Closing will be scheduled for post clean-up
