DPW utility truck. Priority 2. Dave DeVries moves, Mike Hodge 2<sup>nd</sup> for approval. Approved 6-0.

Water well reactivation. Committee discussed awarding priority 1 to this project because of the significant financial payback. Project was given priority 2 as, by consensus, it was felt awarding it a 1 was stretching definitions. Roger Leland moves, Chriss Kowal 2<sup>nd</sup> for approval. Approved 6-0.

Lincoln Street feasibility study passed over due to insufficient details and project timing.

Peaslee telecom system. Passed over due to questions regarding the bundling of the phones with the clocks. Seeking more details prior to making a recommendation.

Lincoln/Peaslee blinds. Priority 4. Dave DeVries moves, Allison Goldman 2<sup>nd</sup> for approval. Not approved, 0-6.
