Minutes of Meeting of October 28, 2010

Public Hearing - Demolition at 192 Ball Street

An application for the demolition of the house and garage at 192 Ball Street was submitted by Mr. John Hanna. The property is reported to be more than 100 years old. The historical commission reviewed information regarding the property supplied by Mr. Hanna at our meeting of October 20th, reviewed NHC documentation on the property, town assessor office information and one member conducted a walk through of the property on October 24th.

A motion was made by D. Haitsma and second by M. Nieber that the property is not considered to be "Historically Significant". The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by N. Corbin and second by D. Haitsma that demolition be approved. The motion passed unanimously.

Additional information is being gathered regarding the other potential funding proposals noted at the previous meeting. The goal is to have drafts ready for review at the November 17th meeting.


CPA Liason
