Approved minutes of the October meeting as printed.

The subject of trees growing up and blocking the view from the north lookout on Mt. Pisgah was broached. The secretary was instructed to contact the owner of the land for permission to cut some of the trees to reopen the view.

The south lookout was also described as beginning to be blocked by trees. No action was taken.

Established a work date of 9 AM, December 8, 2007 for a work party to build the new loop trail on town land off of the Cold Harbor Trail. Workers will meet at the corner of Cherry and West Streets. Scott Karpuk will notify all members and volunteers.

Discussed the various possibilities for applications to the Community Preservation Committee for funds for use in fiscal year 2009. Chairman Bradley requested that members preparing applications get them to him promptly, in detail.

Changed the name of the list of volunteers to "Friends of the Northborough Trails".

Decided to hold no meeting in December.

The chairman announced that the committee will hold an election at the January meeting for chairman, co-chairman, secretary, or any other positions the committee deems advisable. The January meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, 1/22/08.
