NORTHBOROUGH TRAILS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES AUGUST 18, 2008

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the July meeting were approved as written.

Trails Stewards Reports

Sadie Stone replaces Arthur Cole as steward for Talbot and Cole trails.

Marielle Stone reports that the Conservation Commission has approved the Rosemary's Trail. She was unanimously acclaimed by the committee for her work in gaining this approval.

Nancy Kellner volunteered to personally deliver all the paper work on the Rosemary's Trail to School Superintendent Charles Gobron this coming week. The School Committee, having approved the trail's construction, still does not know the exact route. She will also discuss with him the issue of the final establishment of the trail name and will contact Rosemary Joseph's family to see if it approves naming it for her, the former Superintendent.

Construction of the Rosemary's Trail was discussed and we agreed to split the project into three sections. The section crossing private land will be built by the committee and the balance of the trail will be built in two Eagle Scout projects, dividing their sectors at the sewer easement. We will provide money for materials and physical assistance if requested by the scouts.

George Curtis reports that all preparations are complete for participation in Applefest this year. It will be held on September 20. He was also assigned the same job for next year and forever more. Charlie Bradley announced a tentative schedule for our portion of construction work on Rosemary's Trail for October.

Arthur Cole was authorized to organize and manage construction of the Beaver Loop Trail to be done by the committee and volunteers in September.
