7:05 p.m. Bob opened the meeting. Minutes for the June meeting were not available for review and approval.

Trail Status:

Trails are generally in good shape. Bob has sent out a general request for donated lawnmowers to facilitate mowing. Forest might be able to provide one that needs repairs before it is operational.

Projects:

- a) Green Street Conservation Area: Bob will suggest that the town consider contracting for construction of a parking area using available funds.
- b) Hop Brook Area: Bob is exploring options for parking areas. State-owned land near Davis Street may be one option.
- c) MWRA Aqueduct Trail: Town received completed m(8) license from MWRA to allow passive recreational activities on the surface of the aqueduct. Bob will attend a planning meeting on July 25 with the Massachusetts Area Planning Commission to discuss trail markers and related trail-use topics.
- d) Eagle Scout Project: Eric Coughlin is searching for a possible Eagle Scout project. Committee members were not able to provide suggestions at this time, but will continue to think about possibilities.
