## Status of Trails:

General: No major problems have been reported for trails.

Green Street area: The Open-Space Committee has proposed to name this area "Green Acres." The Trails Committee needs to recommend names for trails. The Open-Space Committee will prepare a sign for the parking area.

## Other Trail Topics:

- 1. Hop Brook Area: Community Preservation Act funds totaling \$15,000 have been allocated for construction of a parking area on Davis Street.
- 2. Several potential Eagle-Scout projects were discussed: Construction of Watson Park Loop; Hop Brook extension to shopping center; replace planks on Little Chauncy Trail; reroute Sparrow Trail around wet area.
- 3. Bob has been preparing plans for a bridge across Howard Brook on the Mentzer Trail.
- 4. Bob reported that funds may be available through the American Disabilities Act for construction of handicap-accessible trails. This will be a topic for future discussion.
- 5. Bob suggests that distance markers be placed along the Wachusett Aqueduct Trail. Jim suggested using distances from either the beginning or end of the aqueduct.
