

**Minutes
Board of Assessor's Meeting
April 19, 2010**

Members Present: Eugene Reed and Jason Neuman. Absent: John McSorley
Others: Heidi Seaverns.

7:00 PM Acting Chairman Neuman called the meeting to order.

Mr. Reed informed Mr. Neuman that Chair McSorley had contacted him and he would be unable to attend tonight's meeting.

The Board addressed the signature file.

The Board signed approval for 11 Veterans Tax Credit applications,
Map 55 Lot 3-29, Map 23 Lot 2-20, Map 5 Lot 9-9, Map 17 Lot 39, Map 37 Lot 25-10, Map 5
Lot 10-8, Map 5 Lot 9-36, Map 69 Lot 21, Map 24 Lot 42, Map 18 Lot 6 & Map 7 Lot 9-1.

The Board signed approval for 1 Current Use application,
Map 59 Lots 37-2, 3 & 4.

The Board denied 2 Veteran's Tax Credit applications,
Map 19 Lot 4-4 & Map 13 Lot 24 (no qualifying awards received, deny per statute).

The Board signed approval for a Forest Stewardship Plan for land in current use,
Map 13 Lot 3.

Motion: Reed, second Neuman to deny a Charitable Exemption application (Map 42 Lot 1 &
Map 39 Lot 26) based on the fact that the business is not incorporated in New Hampshire

Vote: 2-0 in favor.

Members reviewed & signed an Intent to Cut for the 2010-2011 tax year for Map 13 Lot 3.

Motion: Neuman, second Reed to assess Gravel Tax Levy for Map 10 Lot 12 in the amount of
\$ 29.44 for 2009-2010 tax year.

Vote: 2-0 in favor.

Members will wait to discuss performance bonds until Chair McSorley is present. Ms. Seaverns
informed the members that she had received an amended contract from CNP for the update.

Members will discuss at their next meeting when the full board is present. Members agreed that
discussion of performance bonds, addressing request for signatures on amended contract, and
whether or not to send property record cards to all taxpayers after new values have been
established should be on the next meeting's agenda.
