25 26 27 28	Ms. Bonser voiced her concerns about zoning in general. How can any ordinance changes better serve the community? If there will be a reorganization of our ordinance this year, should we have an attorney review changes as they evolve?
29 30 31 32	There was continued discussion regarding the proposed zoning changes. Mr. Stockus told the Selectmen that both Mr. Mettee and attorney Mayer are on the same page and working in the same direction.
33 34 35	The Board asked to have a copy of the posted changes which are posted in the Town Office, the Town Clerk's Office and the Land-Use office.
36 37 38 39	Having no further business,  Motion: Bonser, second Bock to adjourn the meeting.  Vote: All in favor. Motion passed 3-0.
