AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY .36 ACRES LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF BEEHIVE DRIVE FROM, VOLUSIA COUNTY URBAN MEDIUM INTENSITY TO CITY OF OAK HILL MEDIUM DENSITY RESIDENTIAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HERewith; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.
