AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY 5 ACRES LOCATED ON NORTH US HWY 1 FROM VOLUSIA COUNTY URBAN LOW INTENSITY (ULI) TO CITY OF OAK HILL AGRICULTURE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.
