A. OPENING

Present at Roll Call: Mayor Douglas Gibson, Vice Mayor Jeff Bracy Commissioner Ron Engele. Absent: Commissioners Robert Livingston and Kathy Bittle.

B. FIRE HYDRANTS – INDIAN HARBOR ESTATES

The Commission discussed where the funds would be taken for 10 fire hydrants to be installed in Indian Harbor Estates. The Mayor stated the City Clerk had finished the Year End budget and there is about \$30,000 of unused funds. The Commission agreed that would be the best place to take the funds from.

The City Clerk stated the City would need to go through the formal bid process starting with a Request for Proposal.

The Mayor informed the Commission that he and Mike Arman had met with James Cameron and a representative from Space Florida and they discussed the basics of the launch site possibility. They also traveled to the proposed launch site. Mr. Cameron stated there will be more meetings like this so each individual Commissioner will be able to attend.

Also on October 10th Jim Ball from Space Florida Strategy Department came to Oak Hill and requested to look at the City's Industrial sites. Mr. Arman and the Mayor showed Mr. Ball the sites the City has.

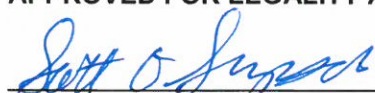
