1. First Reading

The City Administrator read the Ordinance into record by heading only.

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS BY ADOPTING A NEW OFFICIAL ZONING MAP TO DESIGNATE THE ZONING DISTRICTS FOR PROPERTIES REZONED SINCE NOVEMBER, 1992, TO ADD CITY ZONING DISTRICTS CONSISTENT WITH COUNTY CLASSIFICATIONS FOR PROPERTIES ANNEXED SINCE NOVEMBER, 1992, AND TO RESTATE THE ZONING DISTRICTS FOR THOSE PROPERTIES LOCATED IN THE CITY WHERE NO OFFICIAL ACTION OCCURRED SINCE NOVEMBER, 1992; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF THE EXISTING OFFICIAL ZONING MAP FOR THE CITY OF OAK HILL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Mayor stated he will need to abstain from this vote as it directly affects his property.

The Commission had a short discuss in regards to River road and creating a Waterfront District.

Louis Morehead, Scottsmoor, requested his property to be changed to commercial and submitted a letter for the record.

Motion: To approve Ordinance 2015-02. Mayor abstained, Action: Approve, Moved by Commissioner Livingston, Seconded by Commissioner Hyatt. Passed 4-0.

ORDINANCE #2015-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY 14.62 ACRES LOCATED 349 CYPRESS AVENUE FROM LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO AGRICULTURE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

The City Planner explained this Ordinance and the one following is in regards to amending the Future Land Use and zoning for m Residential to Agricultural. She stated that the PLDRC heard both items and recommended approval and staff agrees.

ORDINANCE #2015-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, BY REZONING APPROXIMATELY 14.62 ACRES LOCATED ON 349 CYPRESS AVENUE FROM LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL (R-1) TO AGRICULTURAL (A-1); PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

Motion: To approve ordinance 2015-14, Action: Approve, Moved by Commissioner Bittle, Seconded by Commissioner Livingston. Motion passed unanimously.

The City Administrator read the Ordinance into record by heading only.

ORDINANCE #2015-15

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY .30 ACRES LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF RIVER ROAD FROM CONSERVATION TO COMMERICIAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

The City Planner stated this is a Future Land use change for a property on River Road from Conservation to Commercial; the PLDRC has heard this item and recommends approval.

Commissioner Hyatt expressed her concern that the property was too small for development.

Richard Slaymaker, Property owner, stated he is not entirely sure what he would use on his property but he wants to protect his investment for the future.

Motion: To approve Ordinance 2015-15 Hyatt no, Action: Approve, Moved by Commissioner Bittle, Seconded by Commissioner Livingston.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA, AMENDING ITS FUTURE LAND USE, BY CHANGING APPROXIMATELY .57 ACRES LOCATED AT 251 RIVER ROAD FROM VOLUSIA COUNTY URBAN LOW INTENSITY AND RESOURCE CORRIDOR WITH MOSQUITO LAGOON OVERLAY TO CITY OF OAK HILL LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL AND CONSERVATION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ALL LAWS OR PARTS OF LAWS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

The City Planner stated this assignment of Future Land Use and Zoning to the two properties on River Road are in reaction to the properties being annexed into the City. The PLDRC has heard these requests and have recommended approval.
